The Aztecs will take the field at Tucson Electric Park against the Thunderbirds from Mesa to play their last game of the season.

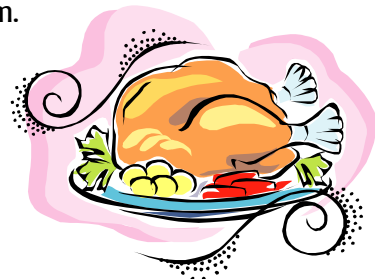
